



Edmonds Community Centre and Pool Burnaby, BC

This project represented a significant investment in the revitalization of the Edmonds Town Centre neighbourhood. Recent population and demographic changes in the City of Burnaby and the decommissioning of another pool created the need for a new full-service recreational centre.

Certified LEED Silver, the Edmonds Community Centre and Fred Randall Pool is 90,000 square foot recreation and aquatic centre comprised of a mixture of steel, cast-in-place and precast concrete, and wood. Constructed over an underground parkade, the centre's amenities include a large natatorium, a 12,000 square foot twin gymnasium, multi-purpose rooms, fitness centre, administration offices, and a pre-school facility.

The use of expressive shapes, bright, welcoming entrances, and creative exterior details work toward generating awareness of the facility and reinforcing its role as a neighbourhood hub.
